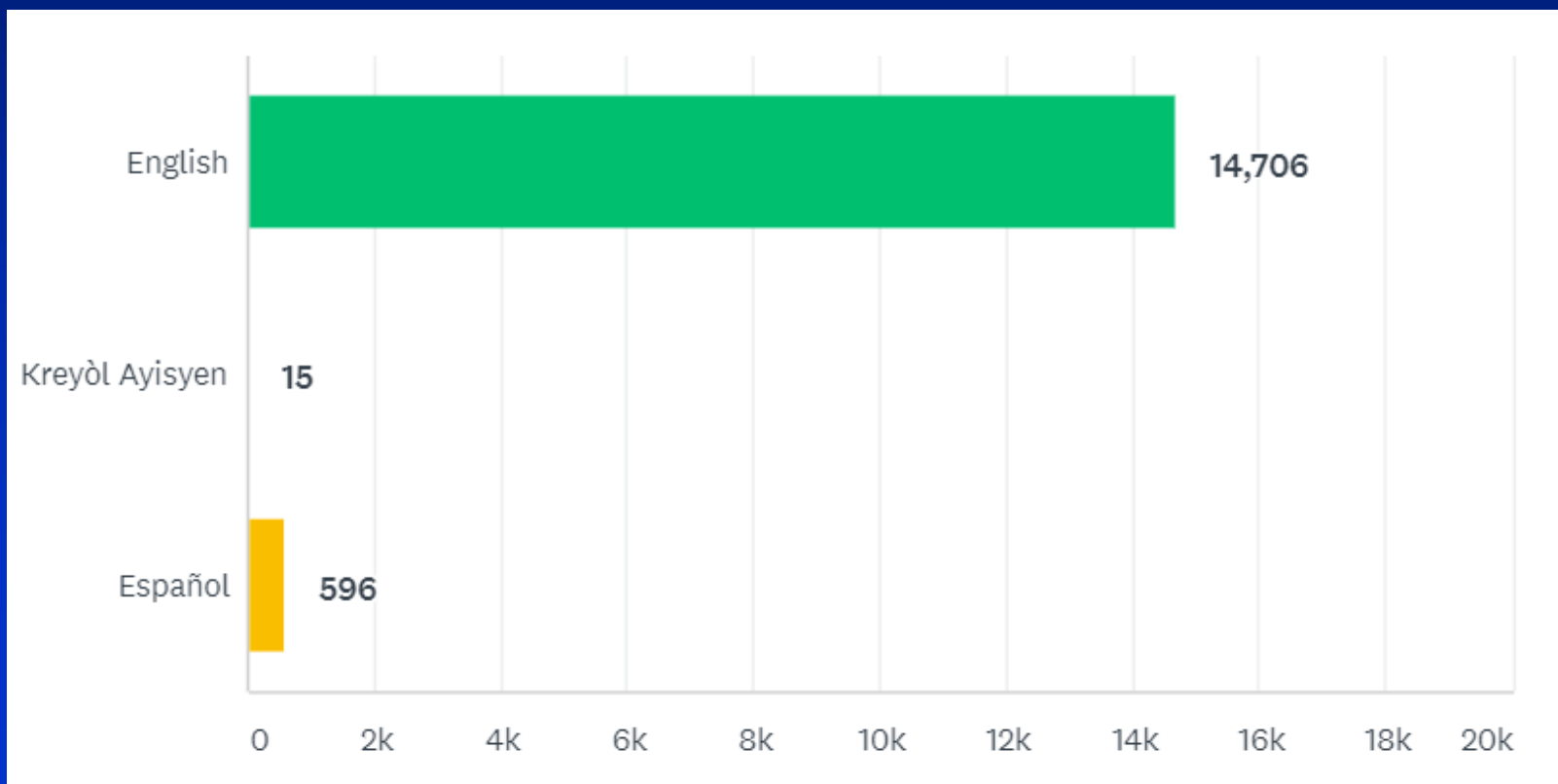

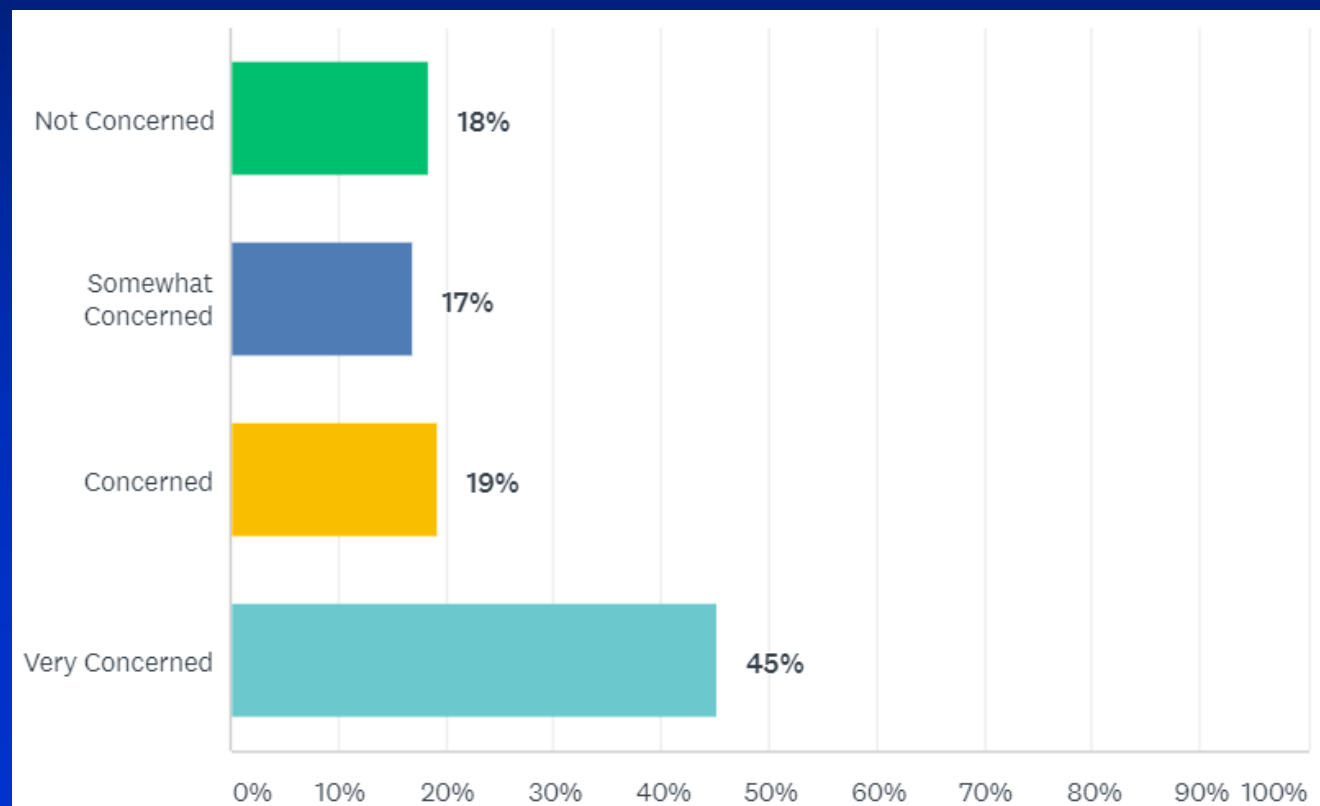
In what language do you write most fluently?

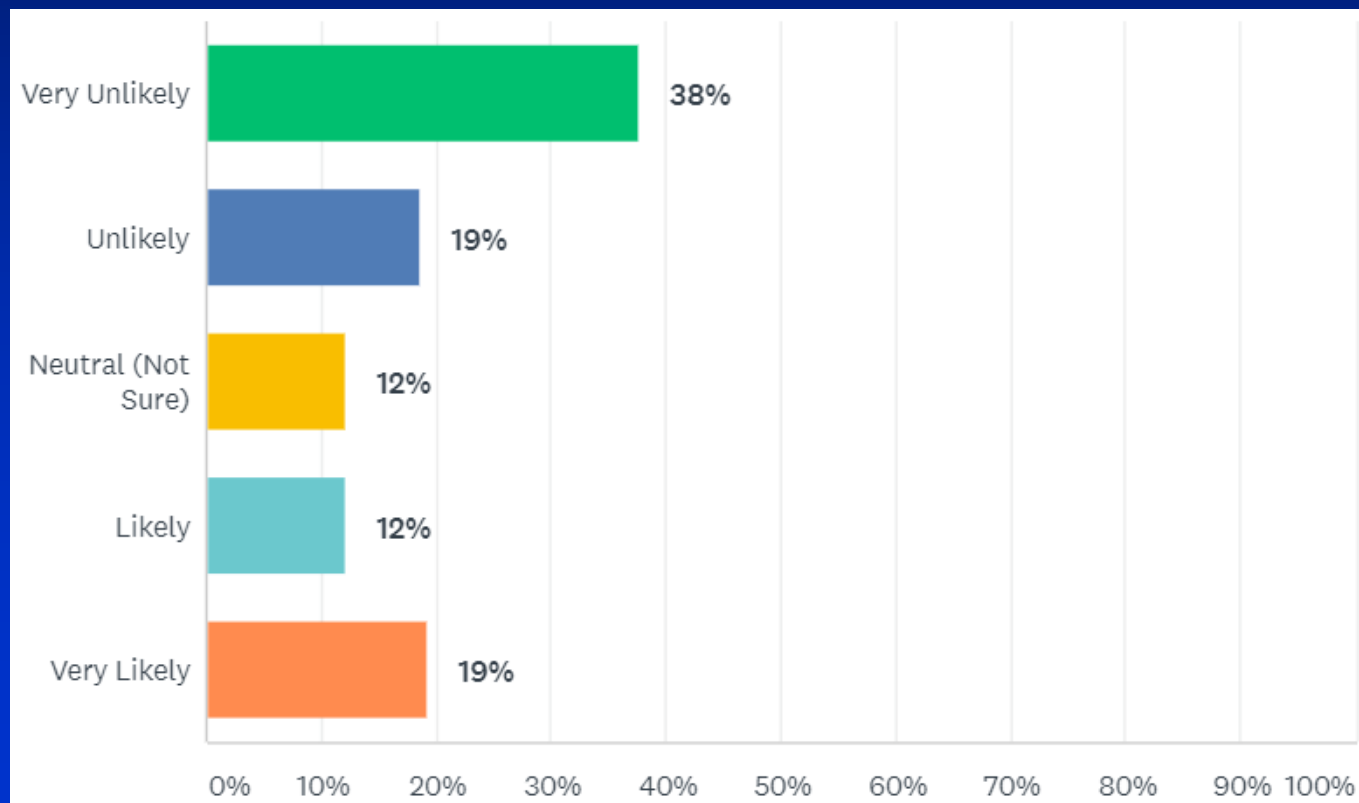
How concerned are you about businesses enforcing social distancing guidelines and other proper COVID-19 prevention health protocols (e.g., wearing masks/face coverings)?

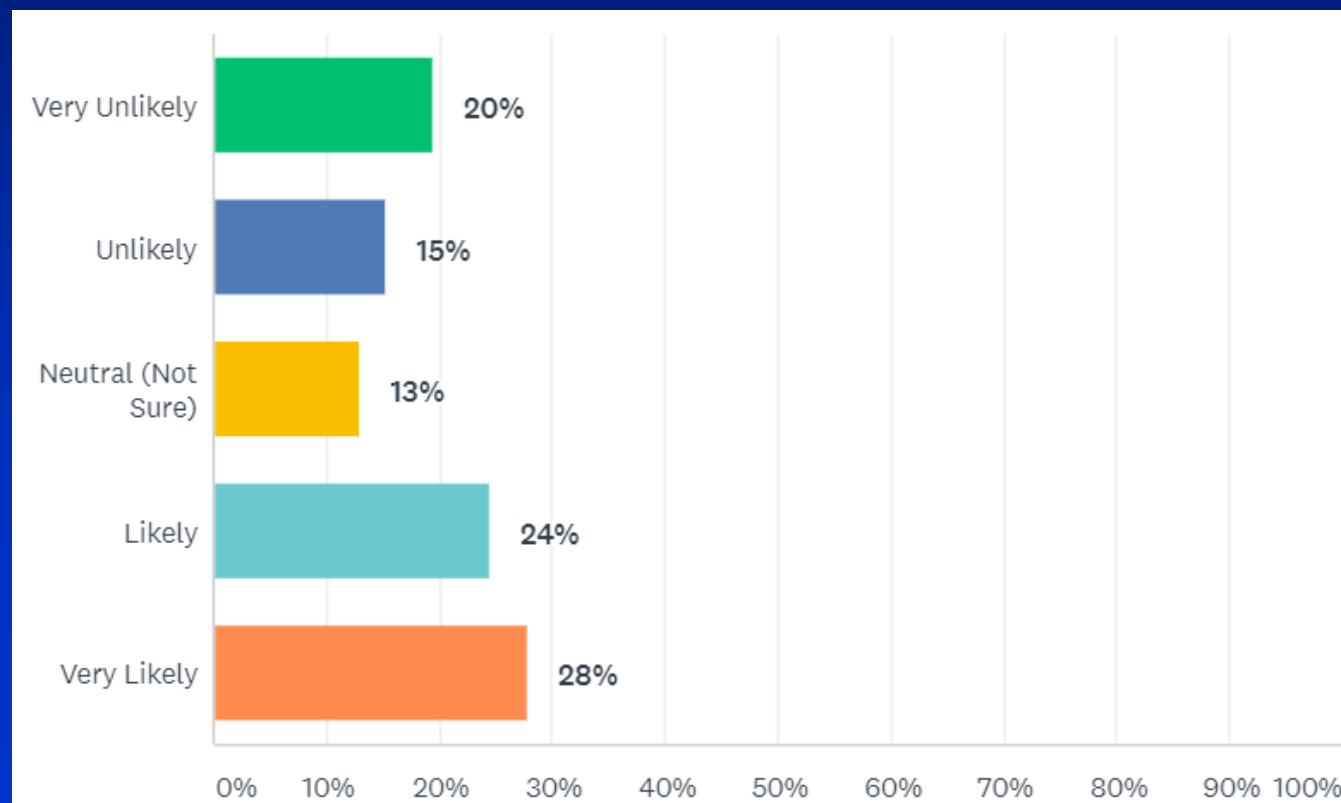
How likely are you to dine at a restaurant in the next 3 to 4 weeks?

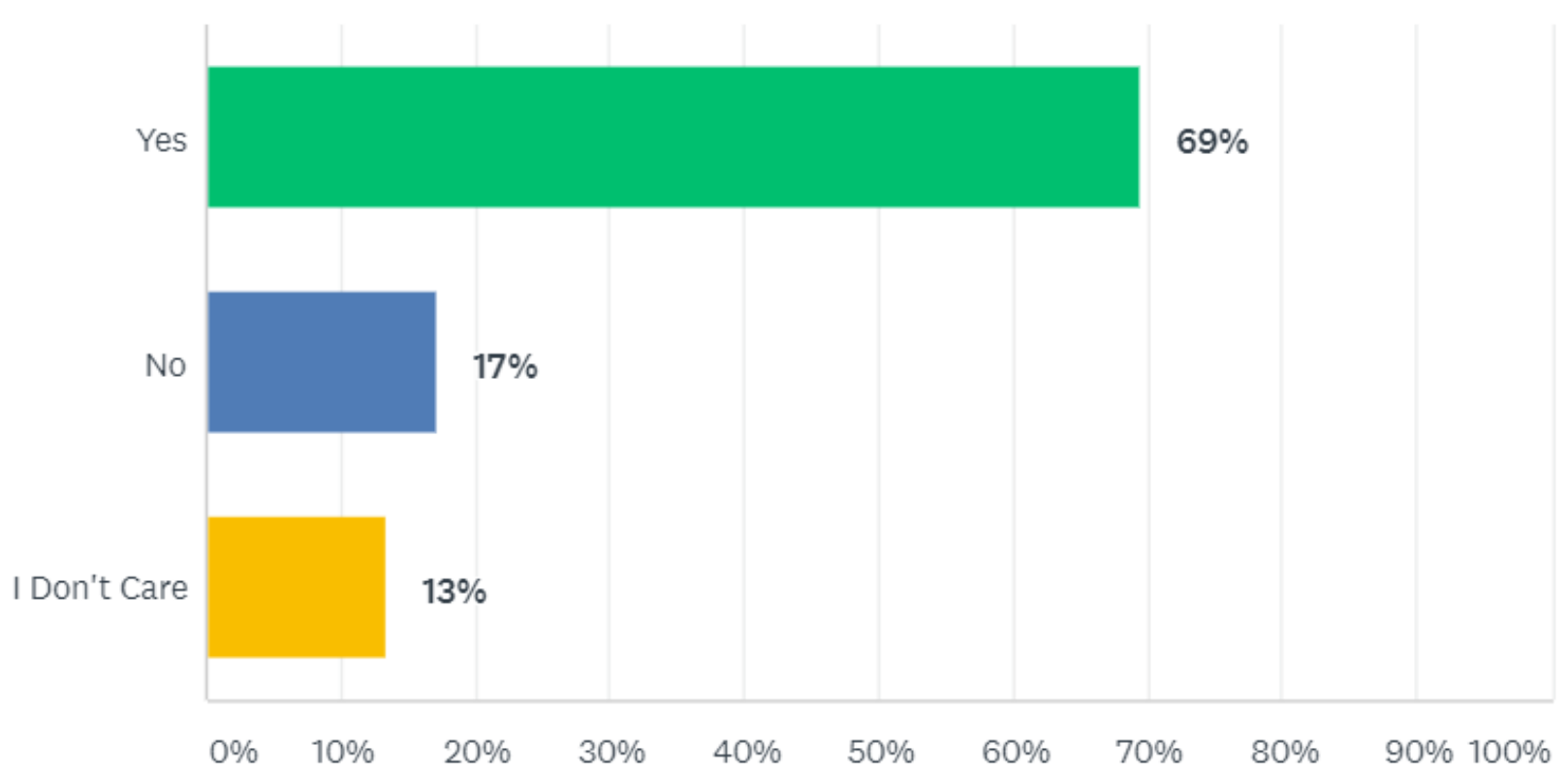
How likely are you to shop in a store in the next 3 to 4 weeks?

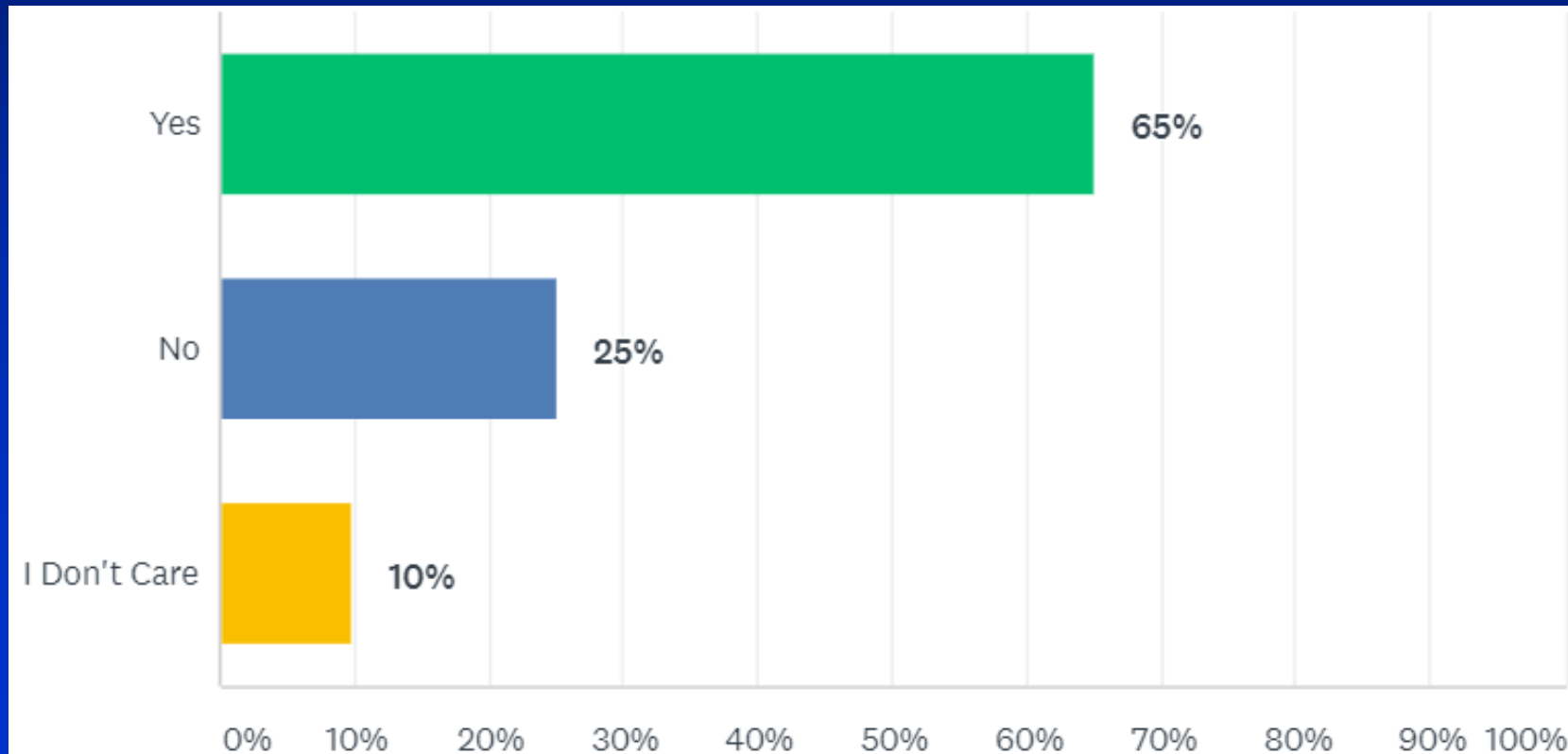
Are you more likely to shop in a store or dine at a restaurant that enforces a policy requiring all employees to wear masks/face coverings at all times?

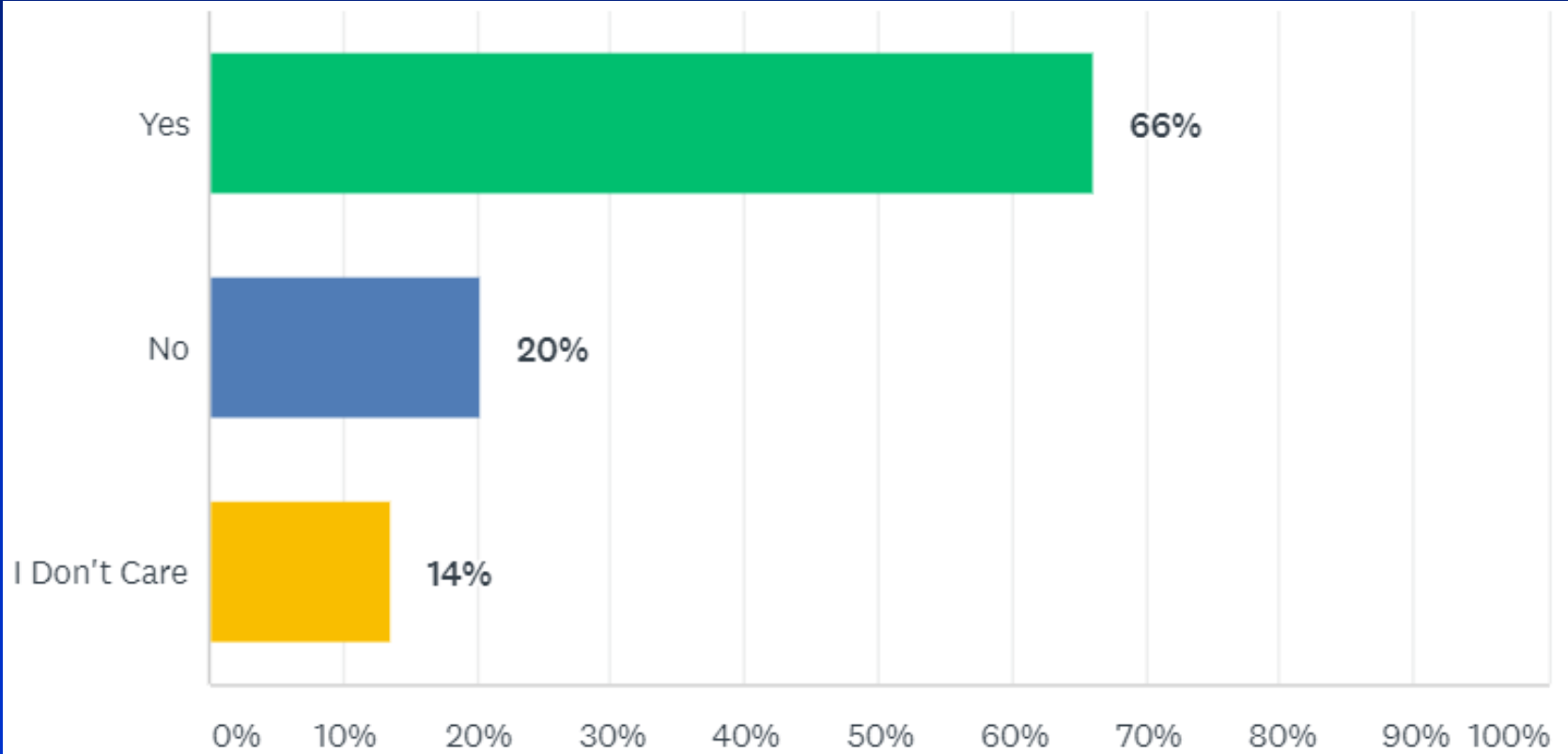

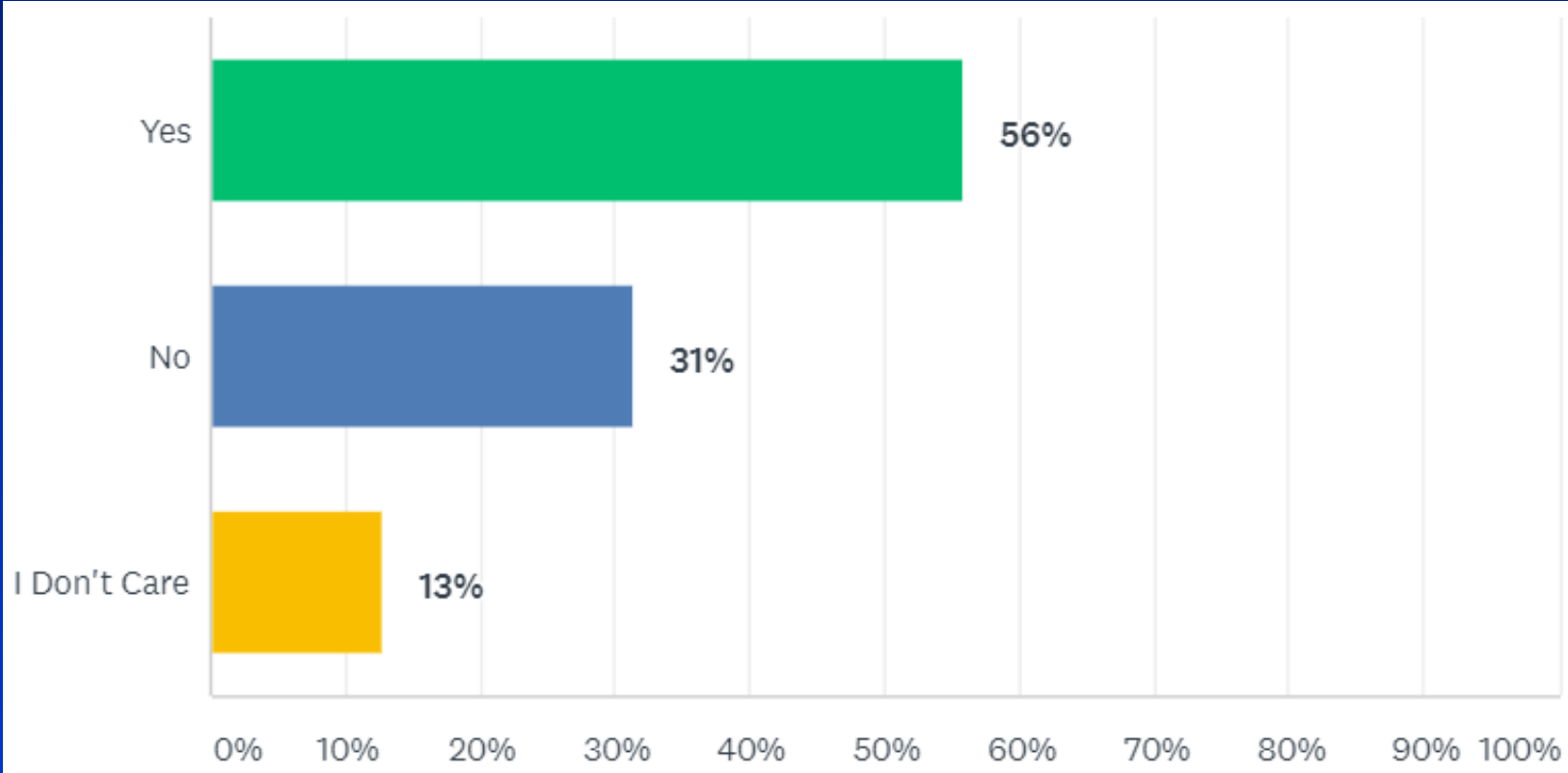

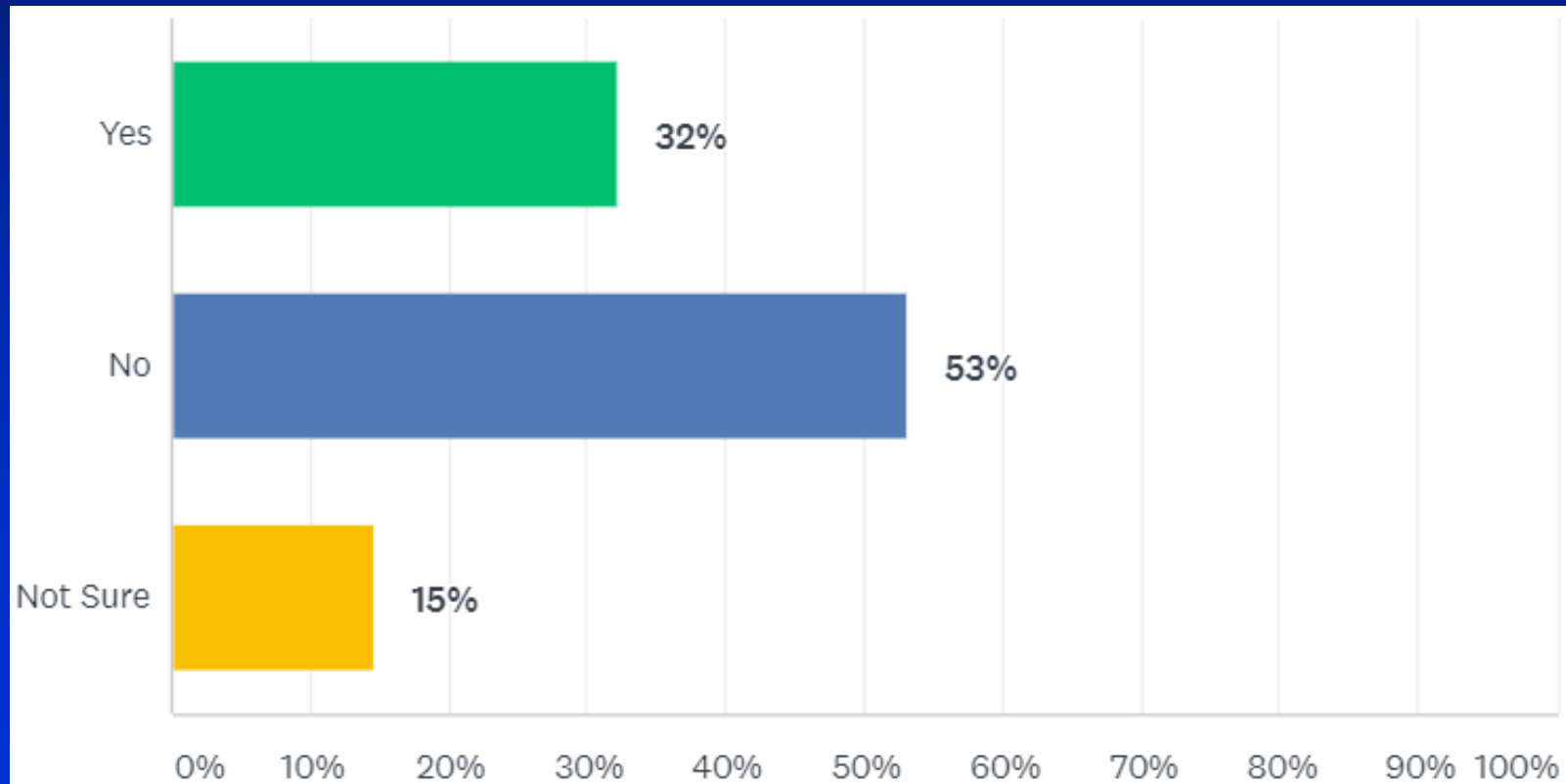

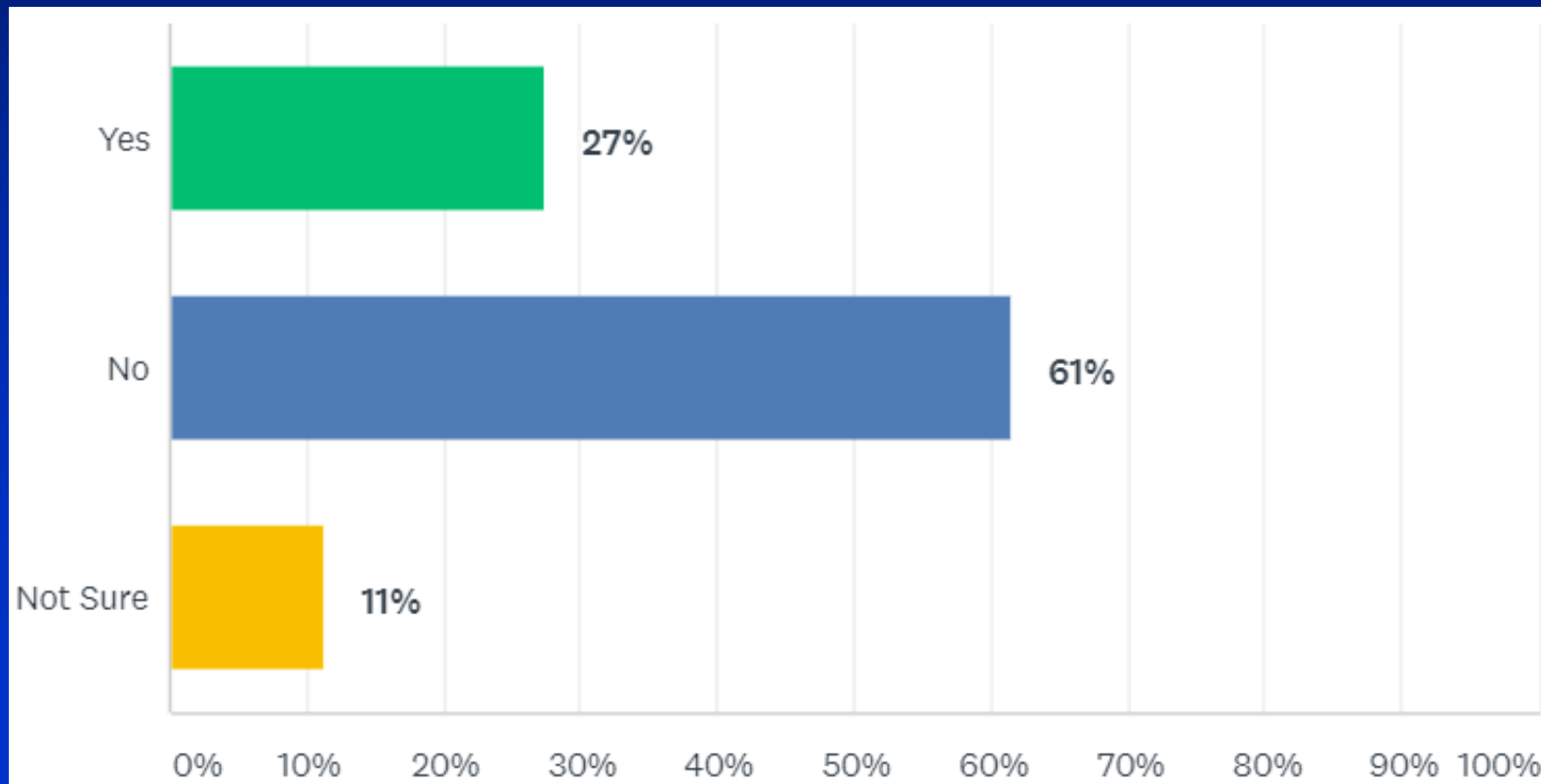
Would you attend a gathering of more than 50 people if all safety/health precautions were taken?

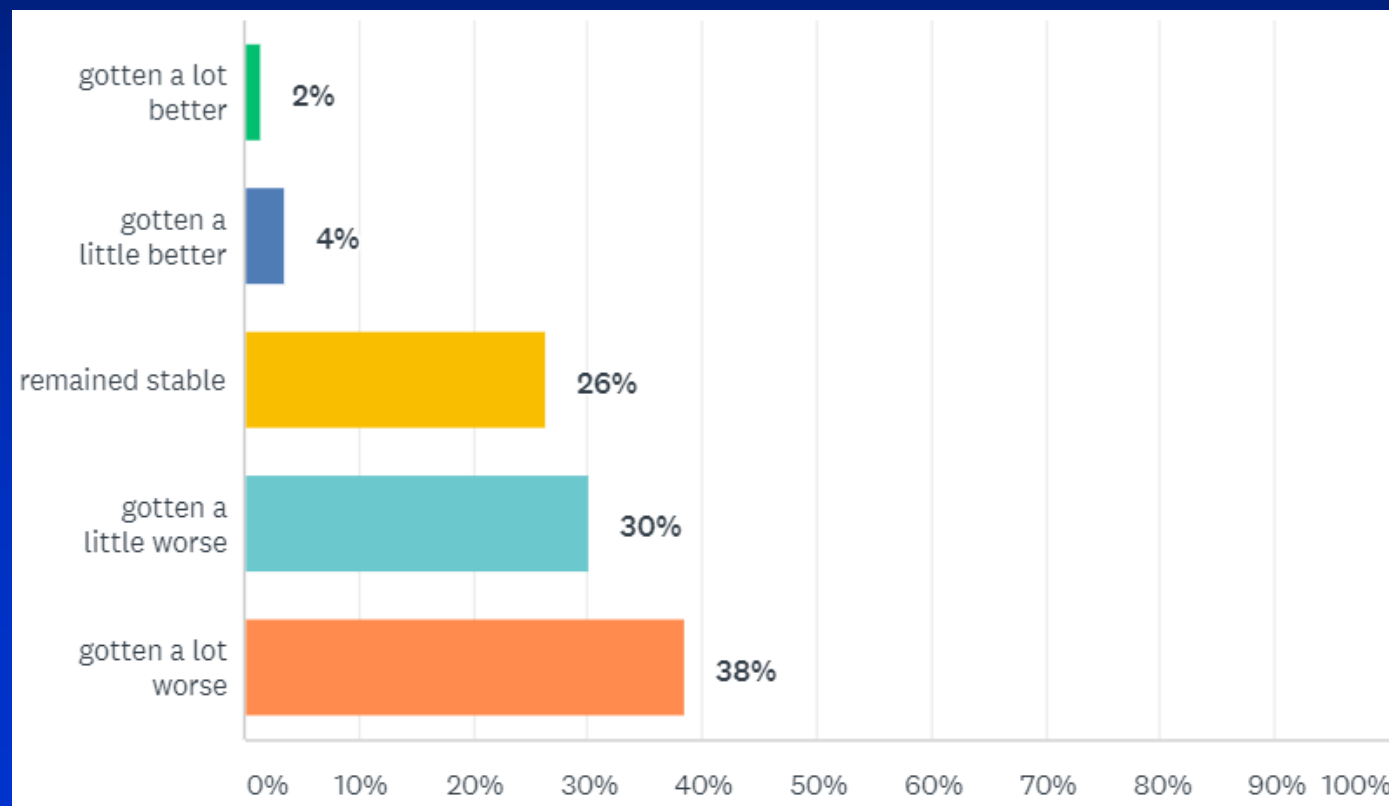

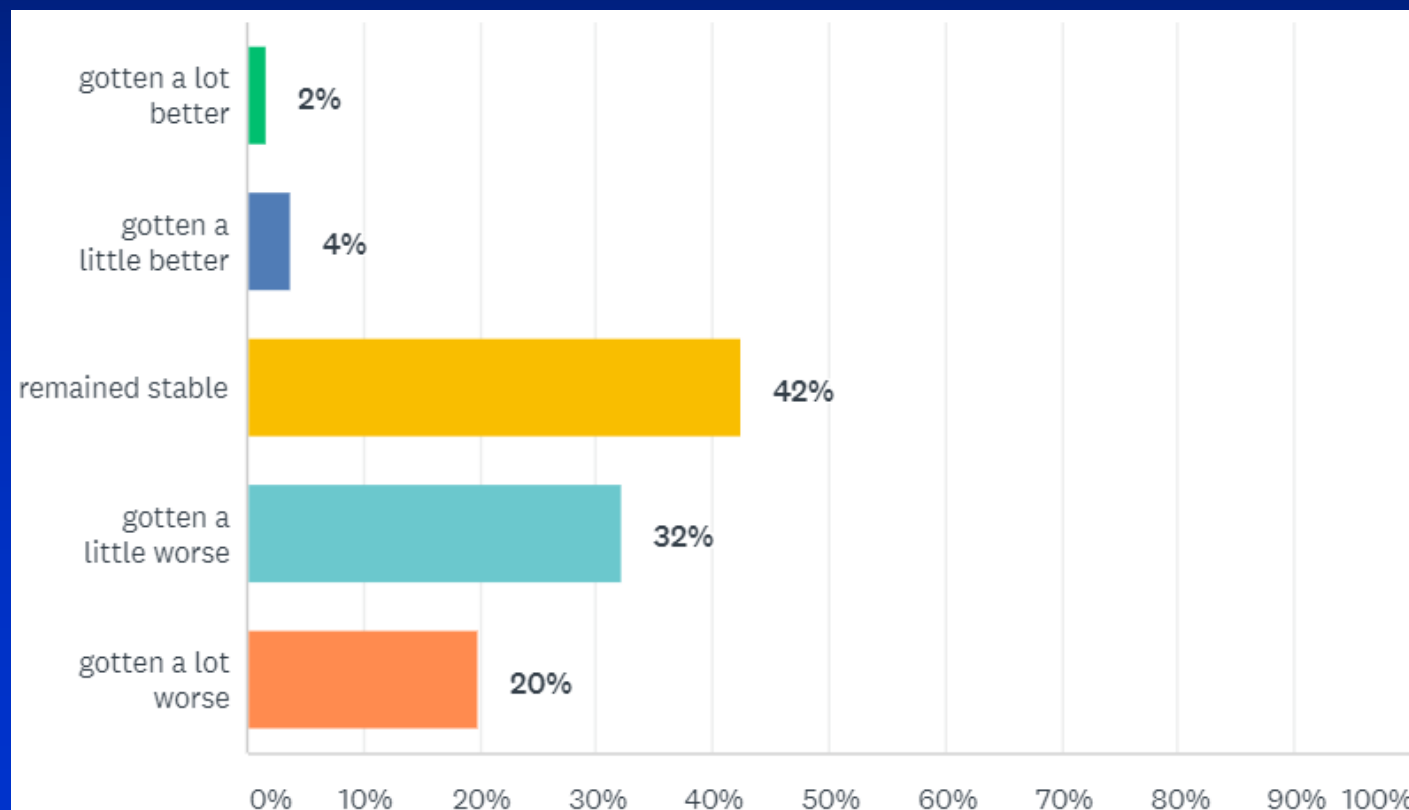

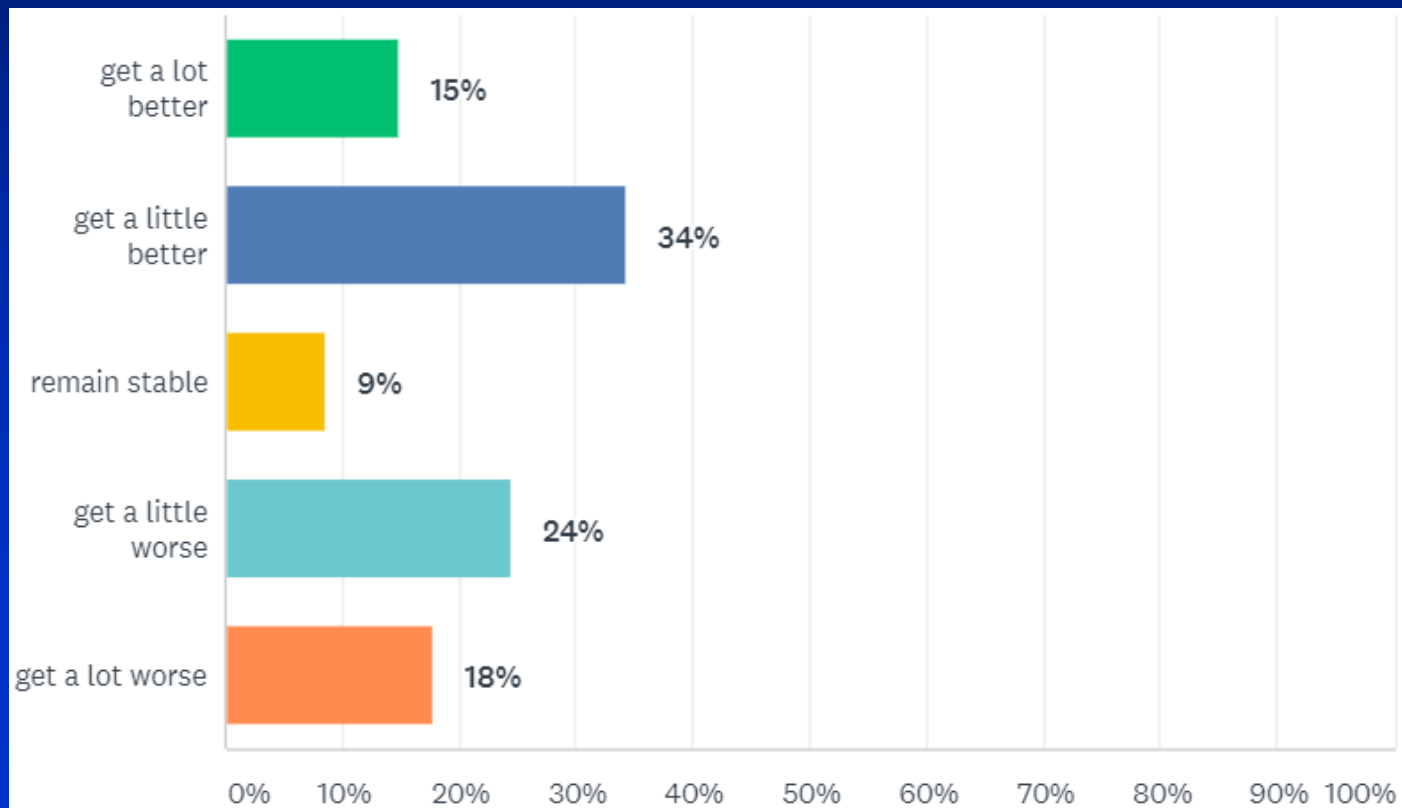

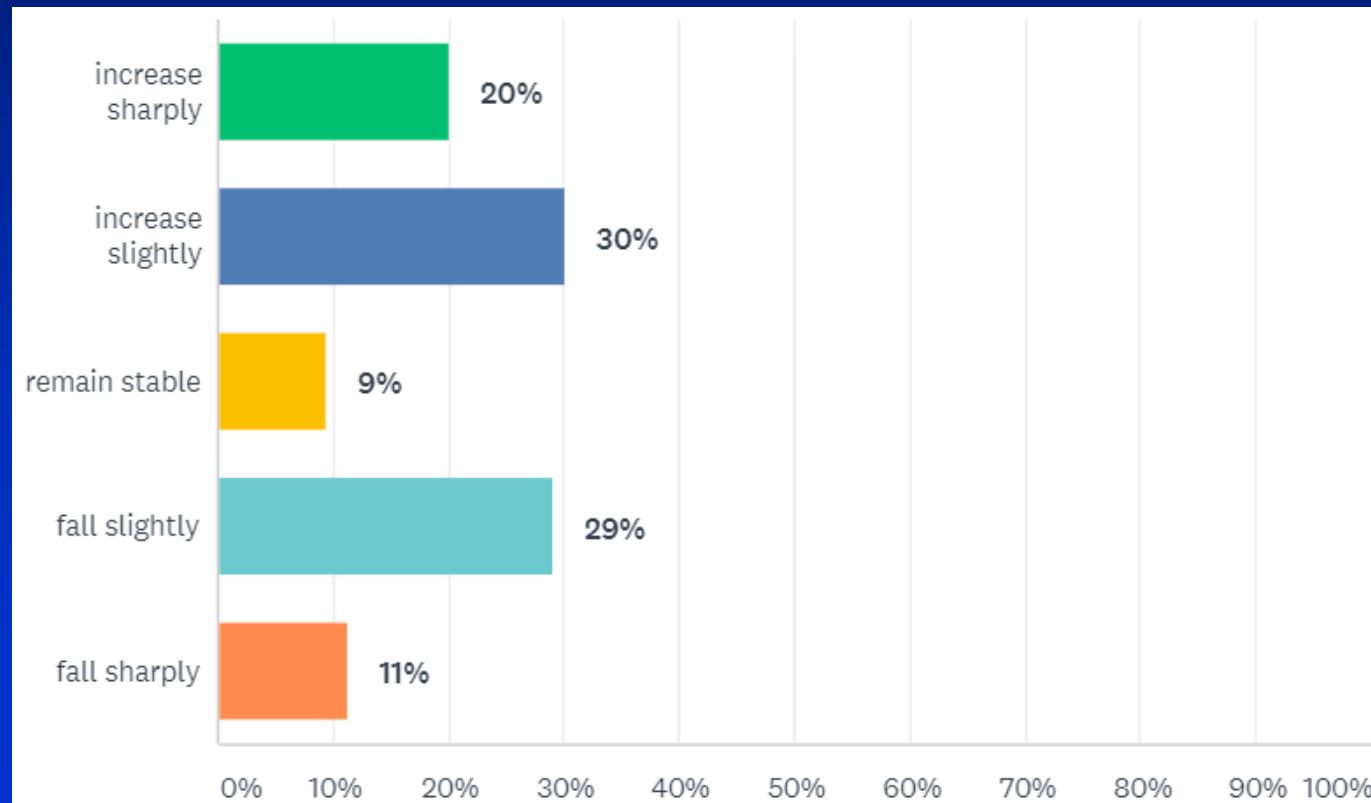

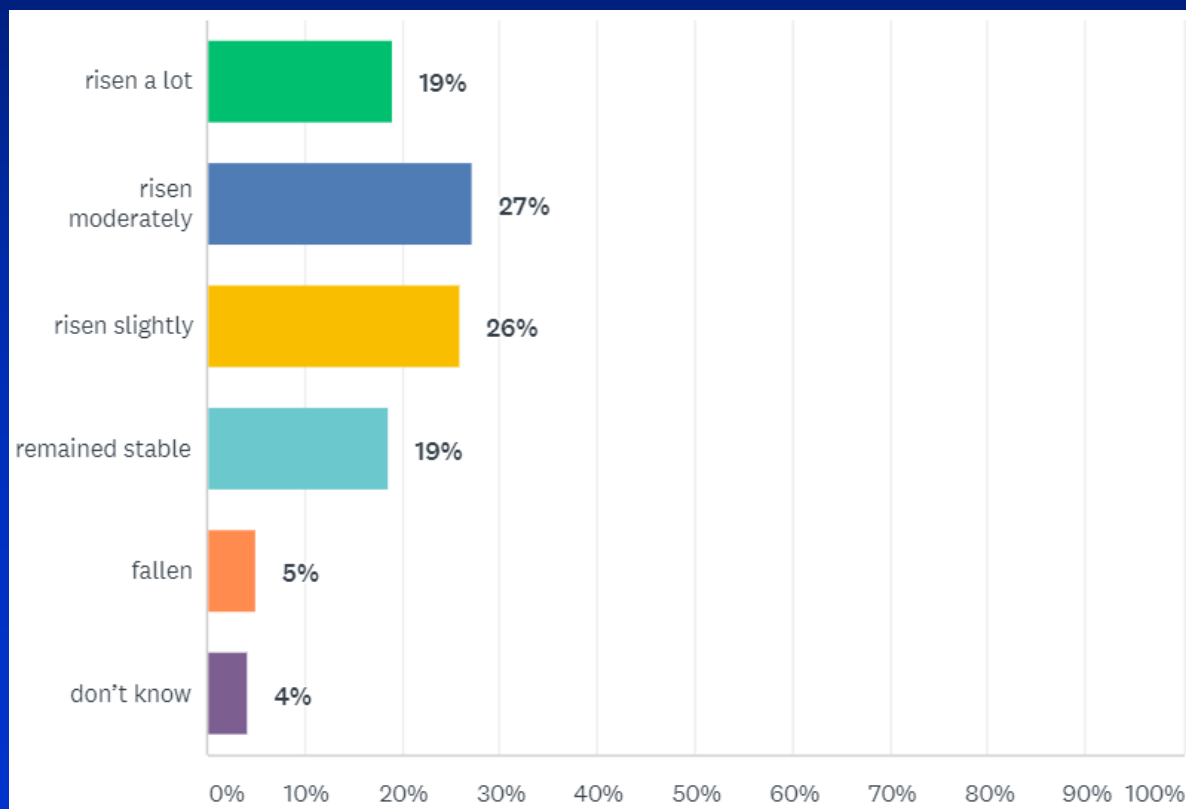
In your opinion, the number of people unemployed in Orange County over the next six months will...

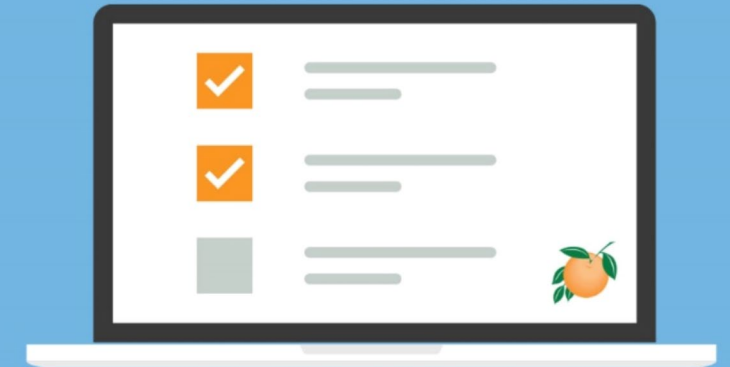

- **Business Practices**

- **Economic Outlook**

- Conditions have changed
- Optimism regarding a recovery
